


Renewal of Academic Information System After 36 Years New Catalog Information Service Corresponding to Digital Resources to Be Introduced from 2022

- The project will be implemented by coordinating with library systems of the user libraries, with a view to establishing a library system and network which will handle digitized resources, such as electronic journals and eBooks.
- The new electronic resource management service will be released in 2022, and the new NACSIS-CAT/ILL is expected to be launched in 2023. These new systems will contribute to the improvement and optimization of university library operations, and the digital transformation of access to academic resources.







The new NACSIS-CAT/ILL System 1



- the Controlled Bibliographic Service (CBS) (OCLC)
- <u>CBS will support the existing CATP format</u> to exchange the MARC records with the user libraries.
- The bibliographic data in the underlying system is <u>compliant with the</u> <u>international standard MARC21</u>, allowing for an easy exchange of the metadata distributed internationally with overseas institutions.
- CMS Co. Ltd., a Japanese system company, will develop the interlibrary loan system, which works with CBS seamlessly.
- The new NACSIS-CAT/ILL system will provide capabilities to adapt to the new international standards such as the Resource Description and Access (RDA), Nippon Cataloging Rules (NCR) 2018 edition, and BIBFRAME.
- It will maintain the current functionalities of NACSIS-CAT/ILL in order to secure the continuity of connections with the library systems used by the 1,300 user institutions.



Electric Resource Data Sharing System 1



Electric Resource Data Sharing System (電子リソースデータ共有サービス)

- Alma (Ex Libris)
- The new electronic resource management system will accumulate and provide common data such as license terms and title lists for electronic resource products submitted by domestic and foreign publishers and academic societies to the Japan Alliance of University Library Consortia for E-Resources (JUSTICE (https://contents.nii.ac.jp/en/justice).

Services currently in-operation

ERDB-JP [In operation since April 1, 2015]

ERDB-JP is a data-sharing service for e-resources published in Japan.

This service is placed on Title Lists (Open data).

License (JUSTICE) [Test released from April 1, 2022]

Sharing license data for electronic resource products submitted by publishers, academic societies, etc. to the JUSTICE. *For JUSTICE members only .

Scheduled to official release in the winter of 2022.





NCR2018 is based on the FRBR (Functional Requirements for Bibliographic Records) model and ensures interoperability with RDA, while also taking into account the publishing situation and cataloging practices in Japan.

Background:

- The National Library of Congress began applying the NCR2018 in January 2021.
- The TRC began applying the NCR2018 in January 2022.
